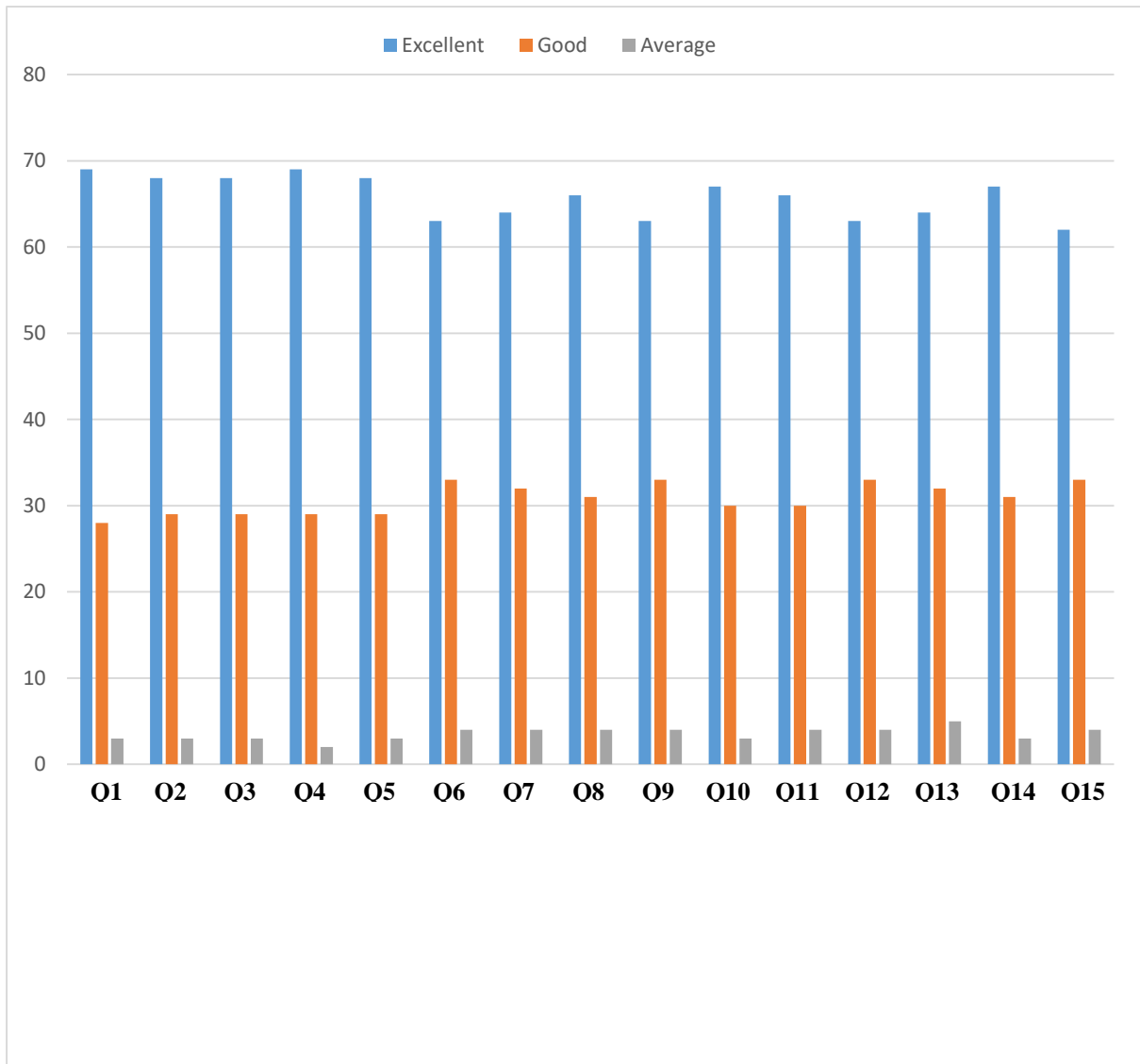

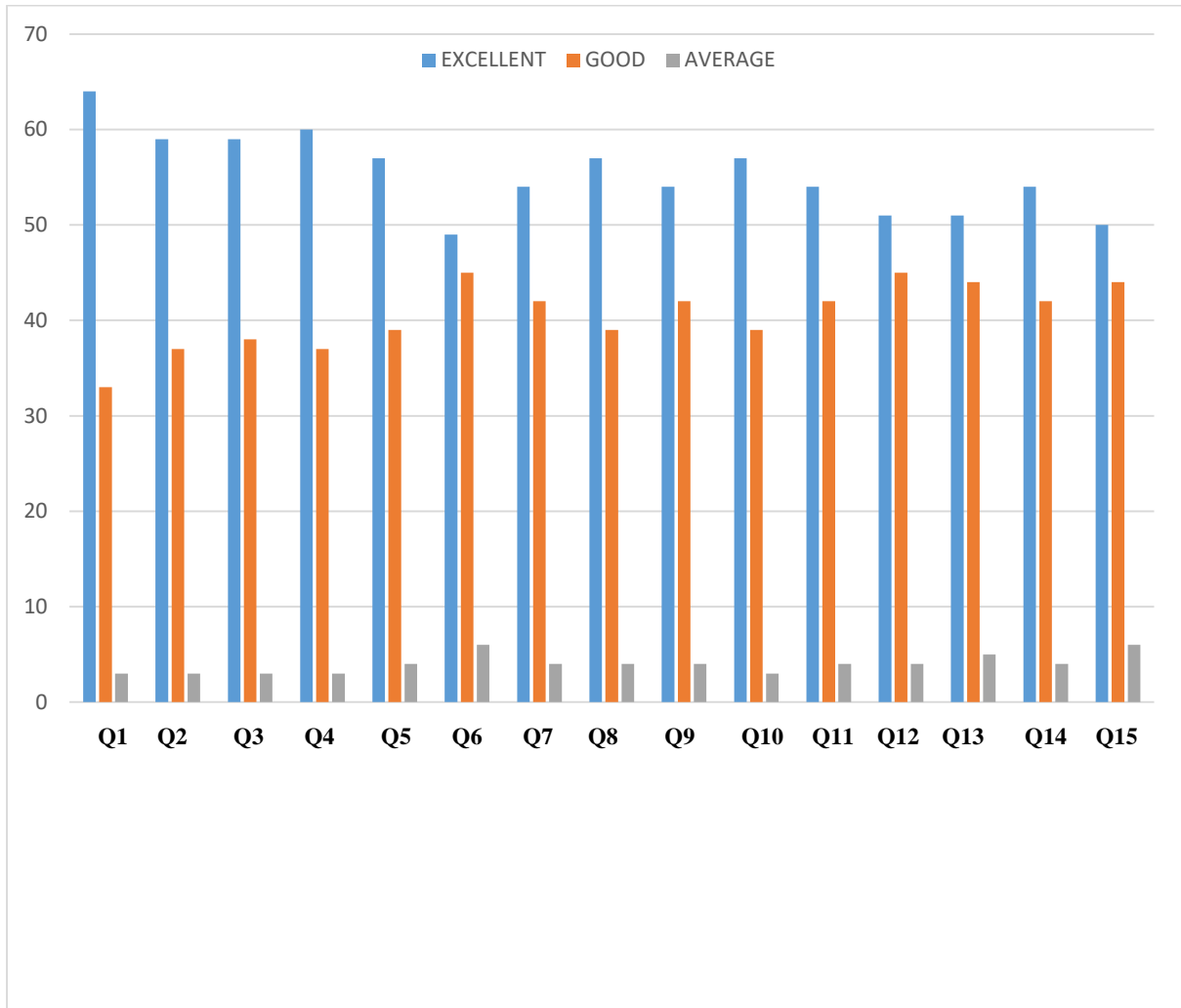

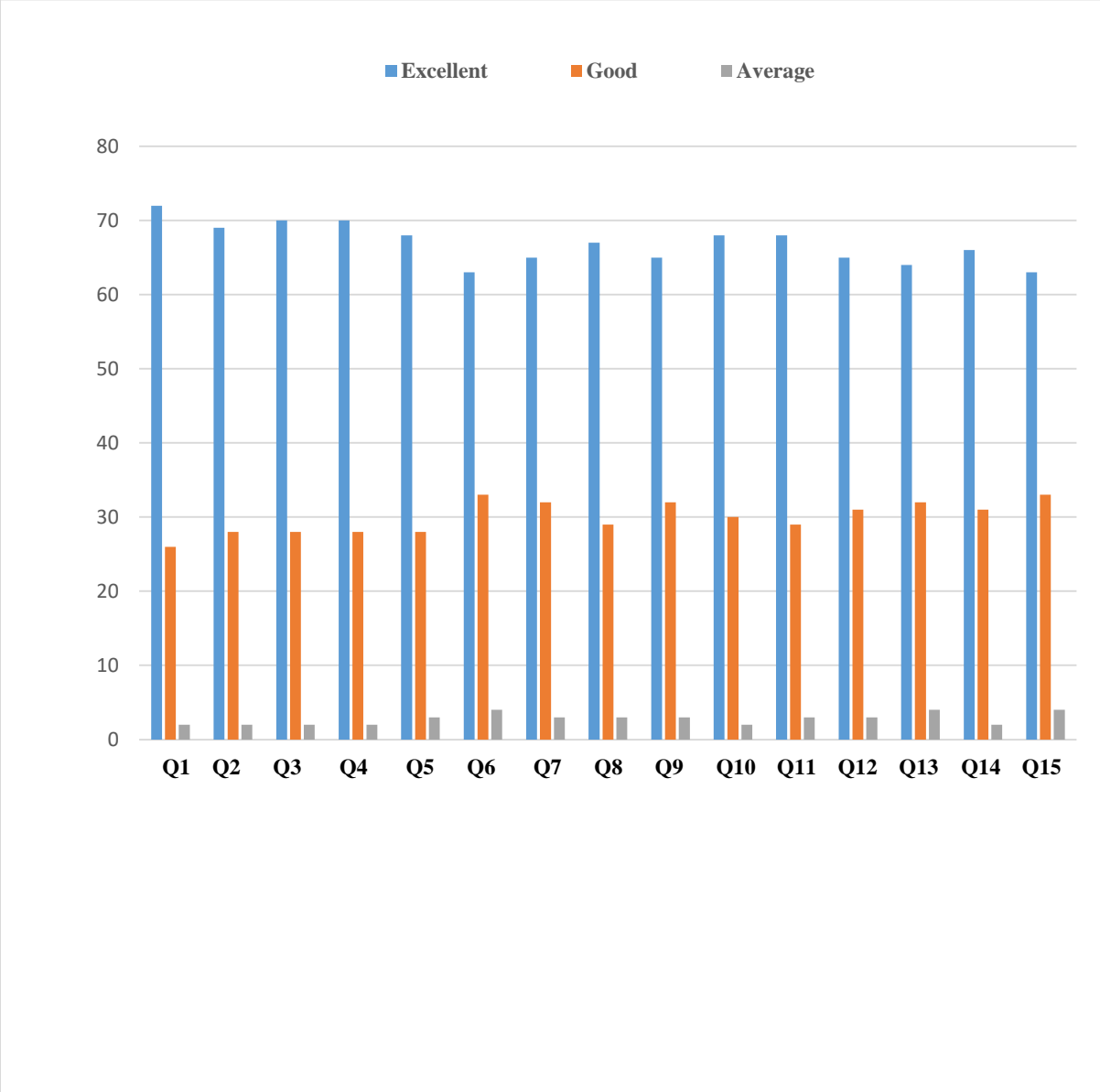
### SHIFT I - ODD SEMESTER - DECEMBER 2022



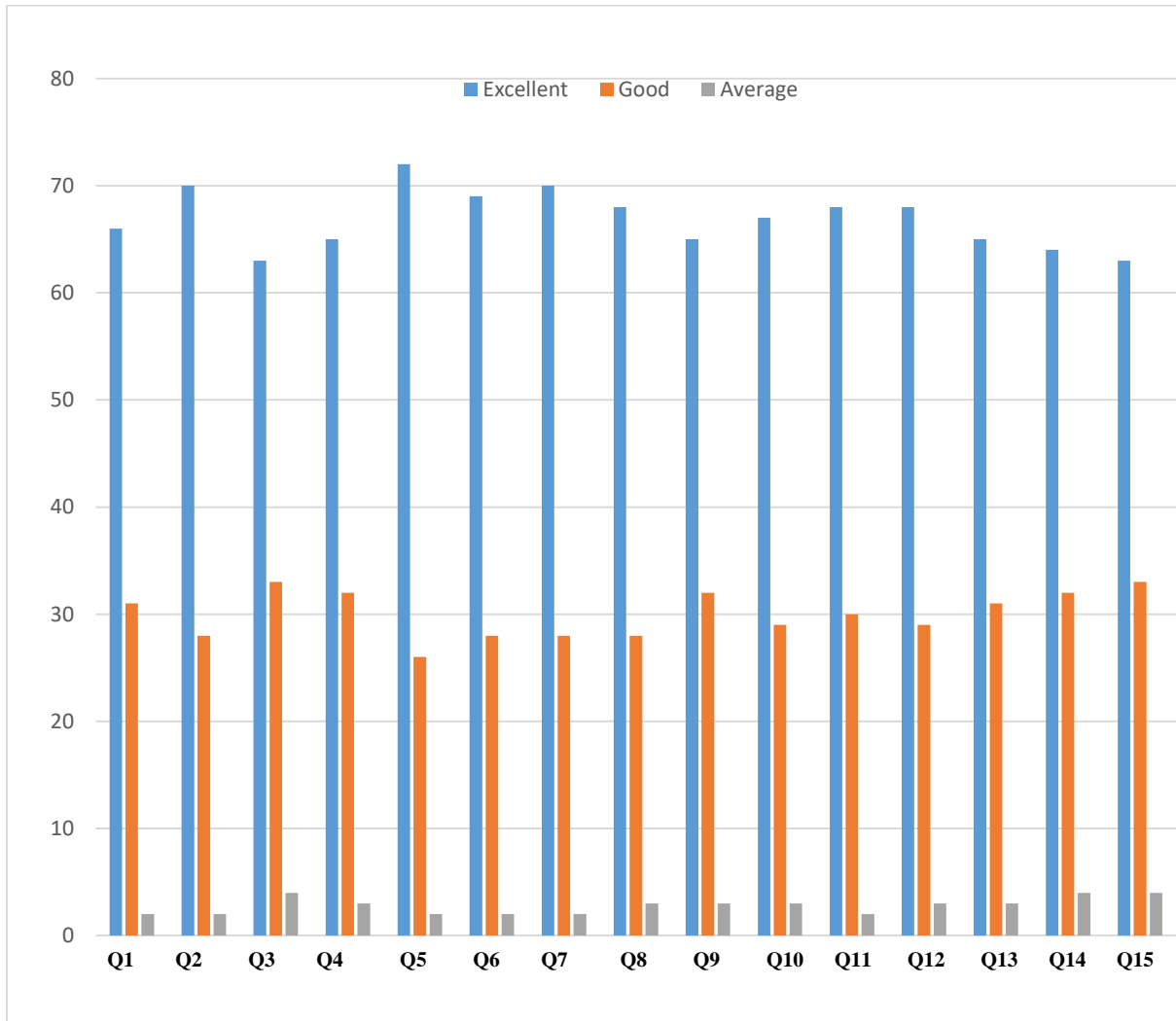
## SHIFT II - ODD SEMESTER - DEC 2022

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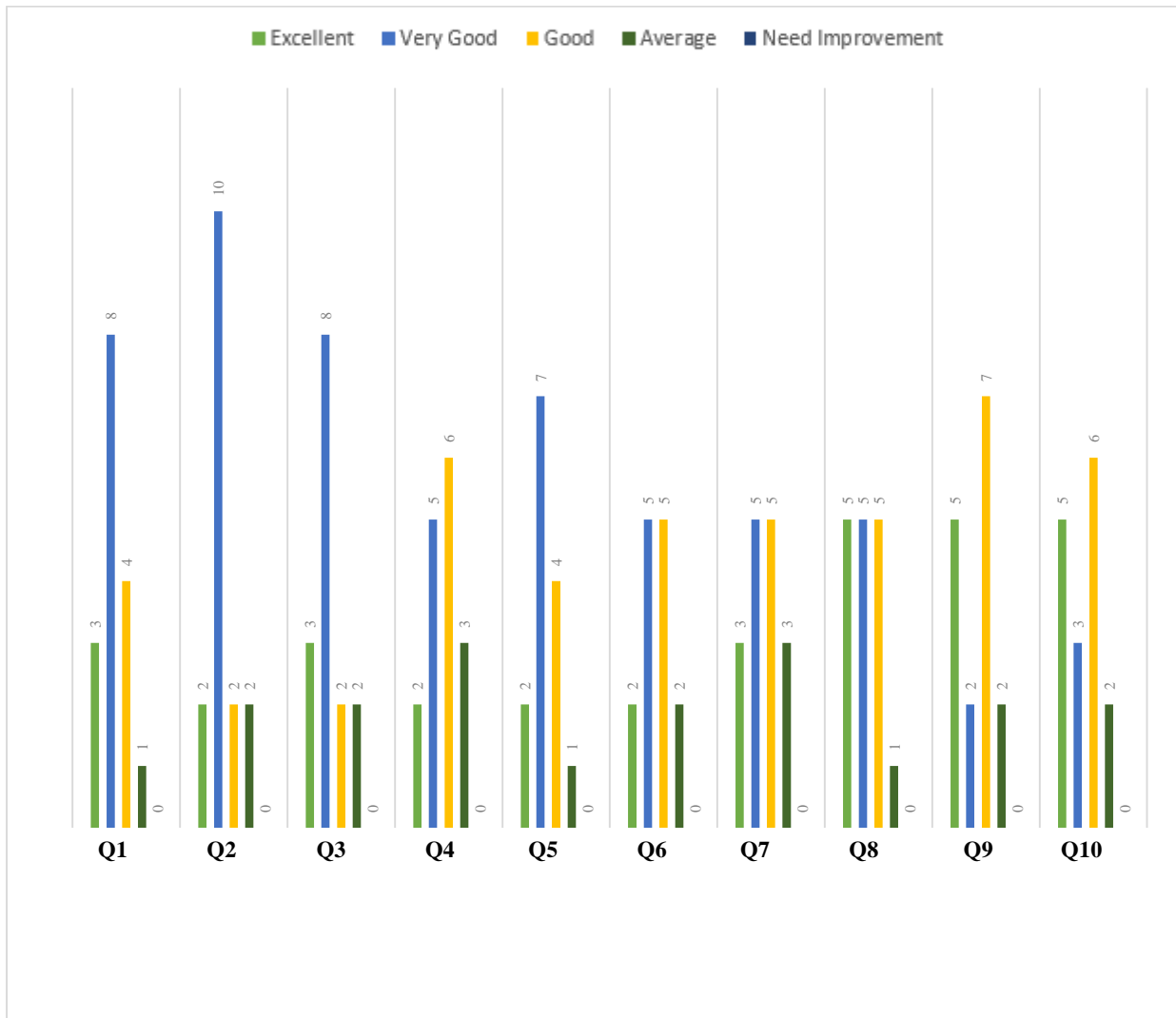
